

- 1) **Prerequisites for participation.** In order to comply with the currently applicable Covid-19 pandemic regulations, every participant in the three FIS Masters Cup competitions at Götschen has to be

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obey the rule. Anyone who has no proof of their recovery (max. 6 months) or a full vaccination cannot participate. In this case, please refrain from registering for a race.

- 2) **Purchase of the lift ticket.** The lift ticket must be purchased individually by each racer with the FFP2 mask on before the start number is issued. Lift tickets are only issued upon presentation of a Covid vaccination certificate with QR code (EU = green passport). In order to avoid queues, we urgently recommend installing and activating the "green pass" with QR code on your mobile phone.

Payment: cash or by card. A VIP-band is issued with the lift ticket and must be attached to an arm. With this tape the way is free to the distribution of the starting number.

- 3) **Issue of start numbers.** The start numbers are picked up individually by each racer with the FFP2 mask on and the VIP band attached to the arm. Payment: Cash.
- 4) **Access to the competition area.** Only athletes participating in the competition, their trainers and supervisors, as well as referees and helpers of the organizer have access to the competition area.
- 5) **Conduct before, during and after the competition** (at the start, in front of the timetable, during the course inspection). If possible, all athletes must always keep a distance of at least 1.5 meters from one another. According to the code of conduct, mouth and nose covering must be worn if the minimum distance is not reached. During the exercise of sports (warming up, competition, cool-down), athletes can do without wearing the mask. You can wear your own mouth and nose coverings. Shaking hands, clapping, hugging must be avoided completely in accordance with the distance regulations.
- 6) **Spectators** - Spectators are generally not allowed.
- 7) **Team captains meetings, draw, review of registered participants.** The meetings are held with the smallest possible number of participants (one team captain per nation) and in compliance with the general rules of distance and hygiene. In the team captains meeting, information is provided about the current corona situation and the applicable local regulations. A minimum distance of at least 1.5 meters between the participants must be maintained during the meetings. If this distance cannot be maintained during the session or on the way to / from the session, a mouth and nose cover (mask) must be worn. The meeting rooms are regularly ventilated in accordance with the general provisions.
- 8) **Award ceremony.** The award ceremonies are carried out quickly and in compliance with the general distance and hygiene rules. Large gatherings of people are to be avoided.
